The System for the Integral Development of the Family of the Municipality of Juárez (DIF) received a visit from the United Nations Children's Fund (Unicef), which

supervised the Akelius program, which is carried out at the Social and Educational Care Centers for Families (CASEF) Zapata and Olivia Espinosa.

Ciudad Juárez, Chih.- In the CASEF Zapata, UNICEF staff closely observed the way in which children and adolescents learn English through electronic tablets in which they must perform different exercises.



In another space of the aforementioned CASEF are the elderly people who, in the same way, have the necessary materials to learn the language.

In total, 47 people participate, including girls, boys, adolescents and older adults who learn the English language at different levels, while in the CASEF Olivia Espinosa there are 68 who attend the courses.

This program started in August 2023 with the assistance of girls and boys from the age of four, who attend one-hour classes three times a week.
